



Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program



Eligibility Based On:

- Veterans who served in the active military, naval or air force, and who were discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.
- Participants must meet the definitions of homeless as outlined in the Homeless Veterans Comprehensive Assistance Act of 2001, HVCAA, P.L. 107-95. Homeless individuals include persons who lack a fixed, regular and adequate night-time residence.
- Participants must be unemployed or under employed.

In 2009, Hillsborough County received grant funds to operate the Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) by the U.S. Department of Labor to address the increased need for intensive employment assistance for homeless veterans. For more information, contact:
