

Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (EHEAP) Available For the Elderly

Hillsborough County is now offering Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program Funds. These funds are designed to help low-income households 60 years of age or older, who have received a past due or final notice for their home energy bill. The program is intended for those residents that are 150% of the federal poverty guideline or below.

Eligibility Requirements:

· At or below the 150% of poverty guideline · Age 60 or over · Disabled or handicapped (homebound may qualify) · Hillsborough County resident · Past due or final notice electric bill · Picture identification
