SUBJECT: Up-dated nomenclature (proper/appropriate term),
Hillsborough County Home Rule Charter

1. Article III speaks to separation of powers. Section 3.01 speaks to the separation of Legislative and Executive powers. The power of the county government shall be divided between legislative and executive branches. No person belonging to one branch shall exercise any powers appertaining to the other branch unless expressly provided herein.
2. Article V speaks to the Executive Branch: County Administrator. The subsequent Sections thereof speaks to the executive responsibilities and powers, etc..
3. Strongly recommend that the County Administrator term of reference be up-dated to the County Executive Officer. This Charter Review Board is urged to give this recommendation favorable consideration and enactment.
