



## Hillsborough County – Homeless/Emergency Shelters

### Homeless Recovery Program and Homeless Adult Living Facility Program

Financial assistance and case management services are provided to the homeless population of Hillsborough County. Eligible participants are provided services which include non-supervised boarding homes, shelter, utilities, food, incidentals, bus passes, and referrals to employment programs. Individuals must be able and willing to develop and participate in a plan for self-sufficiency.

### Cold Weather Emergency Shelters:

The Homeless Recovery Program coordinates with various community agencies to identify and refer clients to the cold weather shelters when the temperature is at or below 32 degrees Fahrenheit. The temperature for a given day is verified by the forecasters located at the United States Weather Service's Ruskin, Florida office. If verified, then cold weather shelters are opened for homeless individuals who need shelter from the cold. These shelters include the following:
