



On-line Banking Security Tips:

You can help prevent unauthorized access to your on-line banking and credit account with these simple security measures:

1. Safeguard your login information and do not disclose to others. (Never respond to e-mails from anyone for any reason if they are requesting your personal information.)
2. Avoid logging into banking or credit sites from a public server. If you must sign in from a public terminal, be certain to log out completely at the end of the session.
3. Never leave your computer unattended during an on-line banking session.
4. Always log off when you are finished with the session by clicking the log out button ("x" in the upper right hand corner).
5. Protect your log-in information by not automatically storing the user ID or password on windows auto fill or under bookmarks which can be accessed easily by anyone with access to your computer.
6. Always close your browser completely when you have logged out to ensure that no one using the computer after you can see your account information.

If you believe that an unauthorized person has accessed your account information, please contact your bank, credit union, or credit card company and the major credit bureaus immediately and report it.
