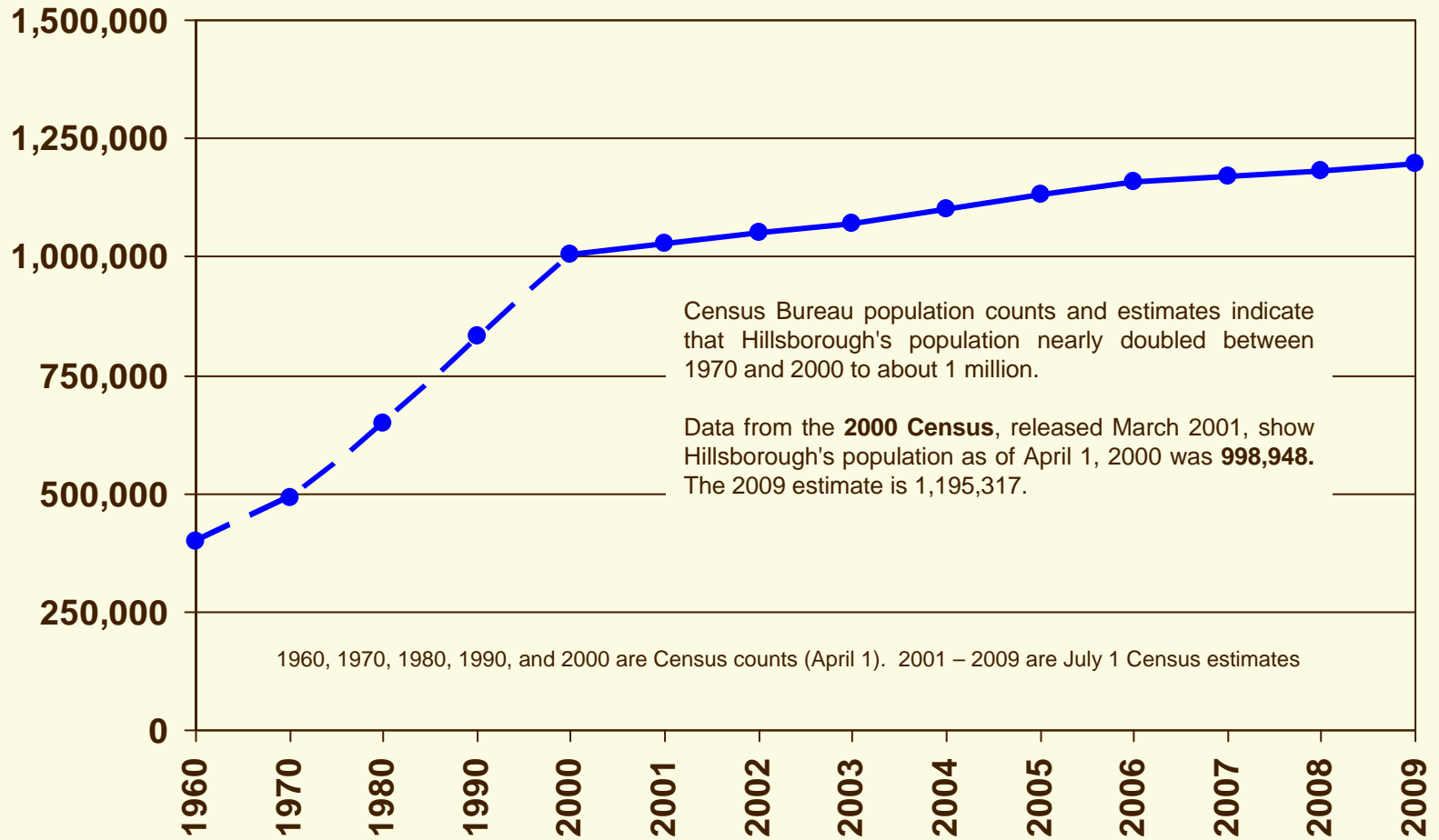


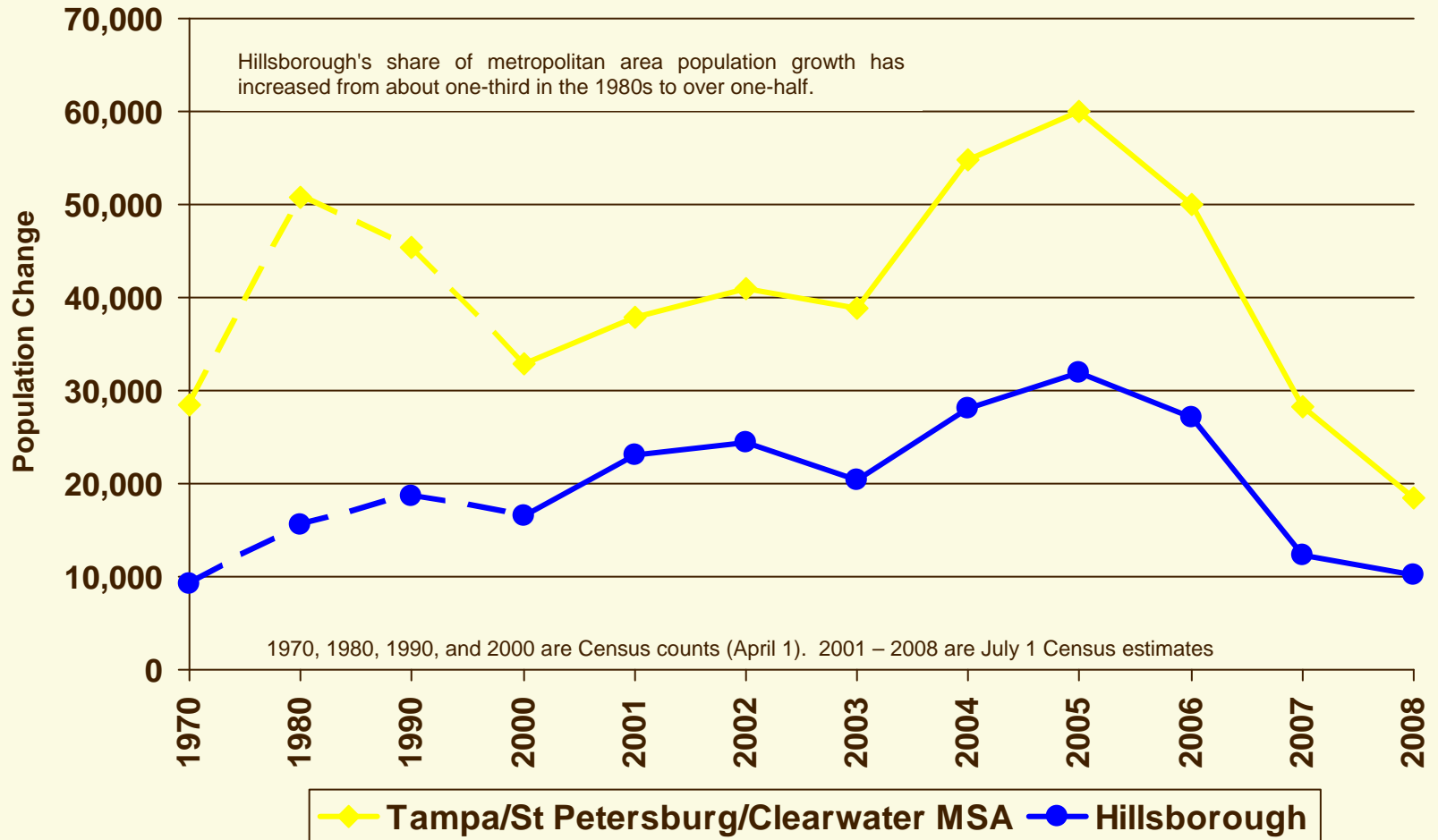

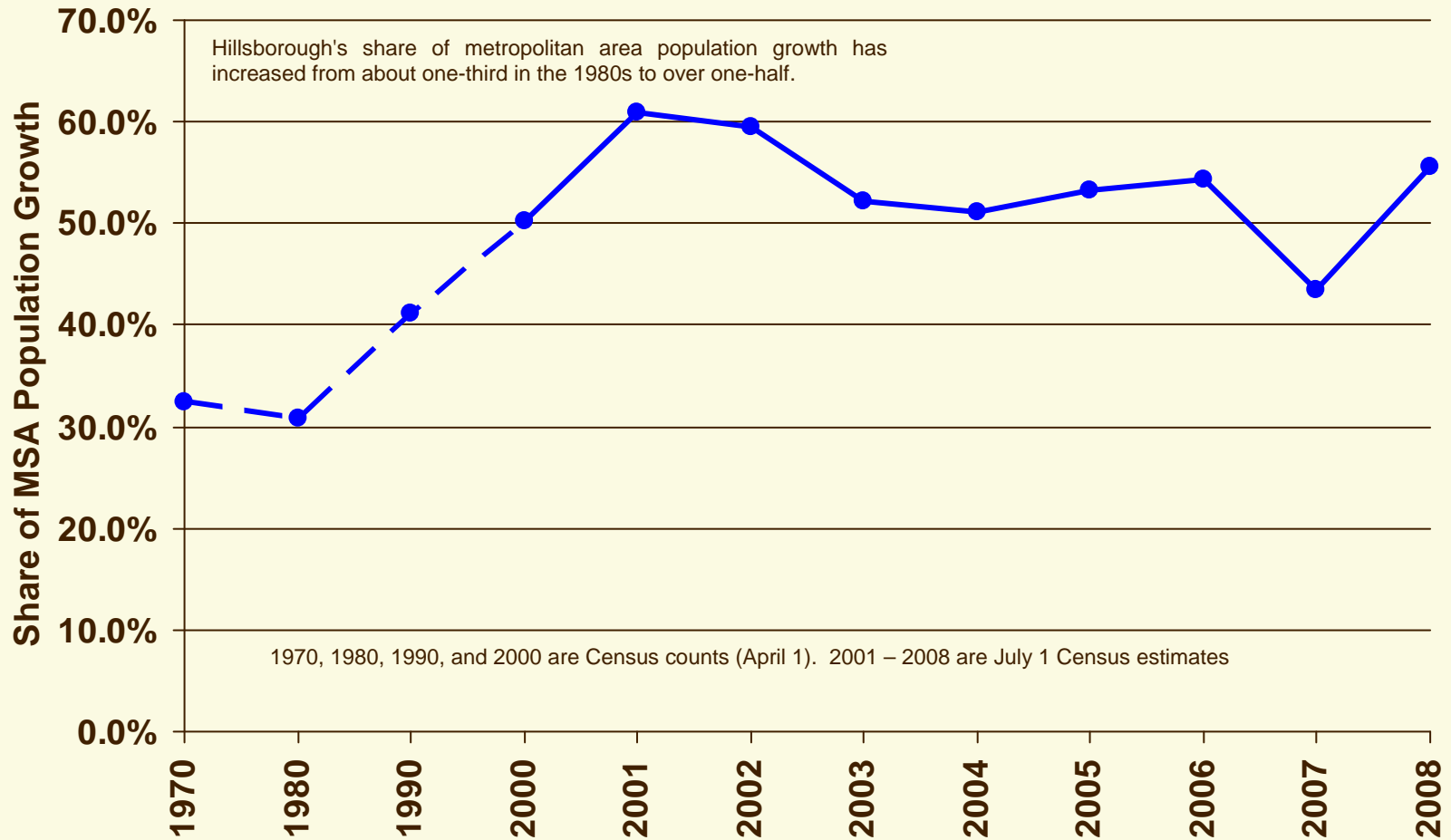
# Population Growth, 1970-2008

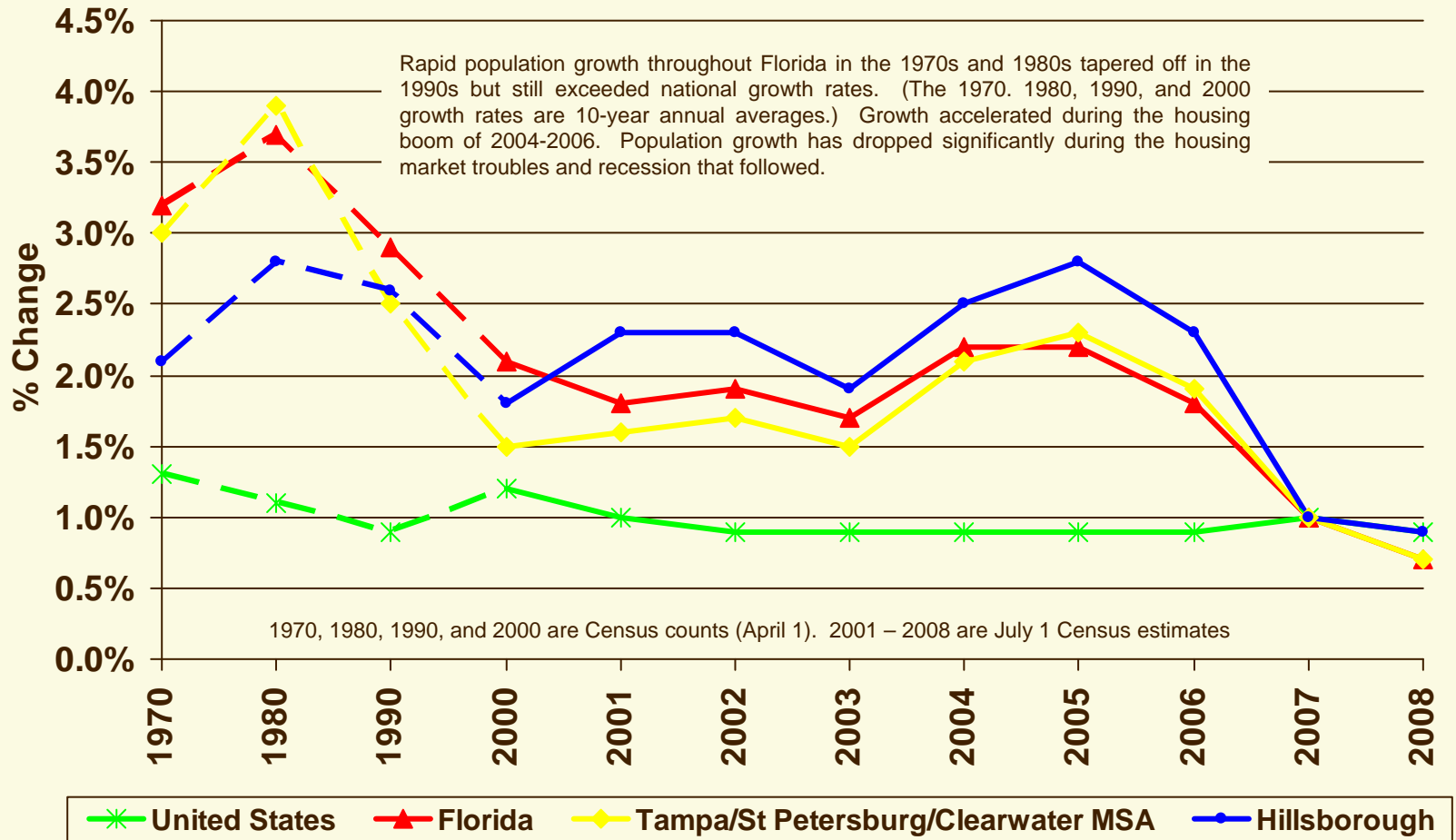
# Hillsborough's Share of Tampa/St Pete/Clearwater MSA Population Growth 1970-2008

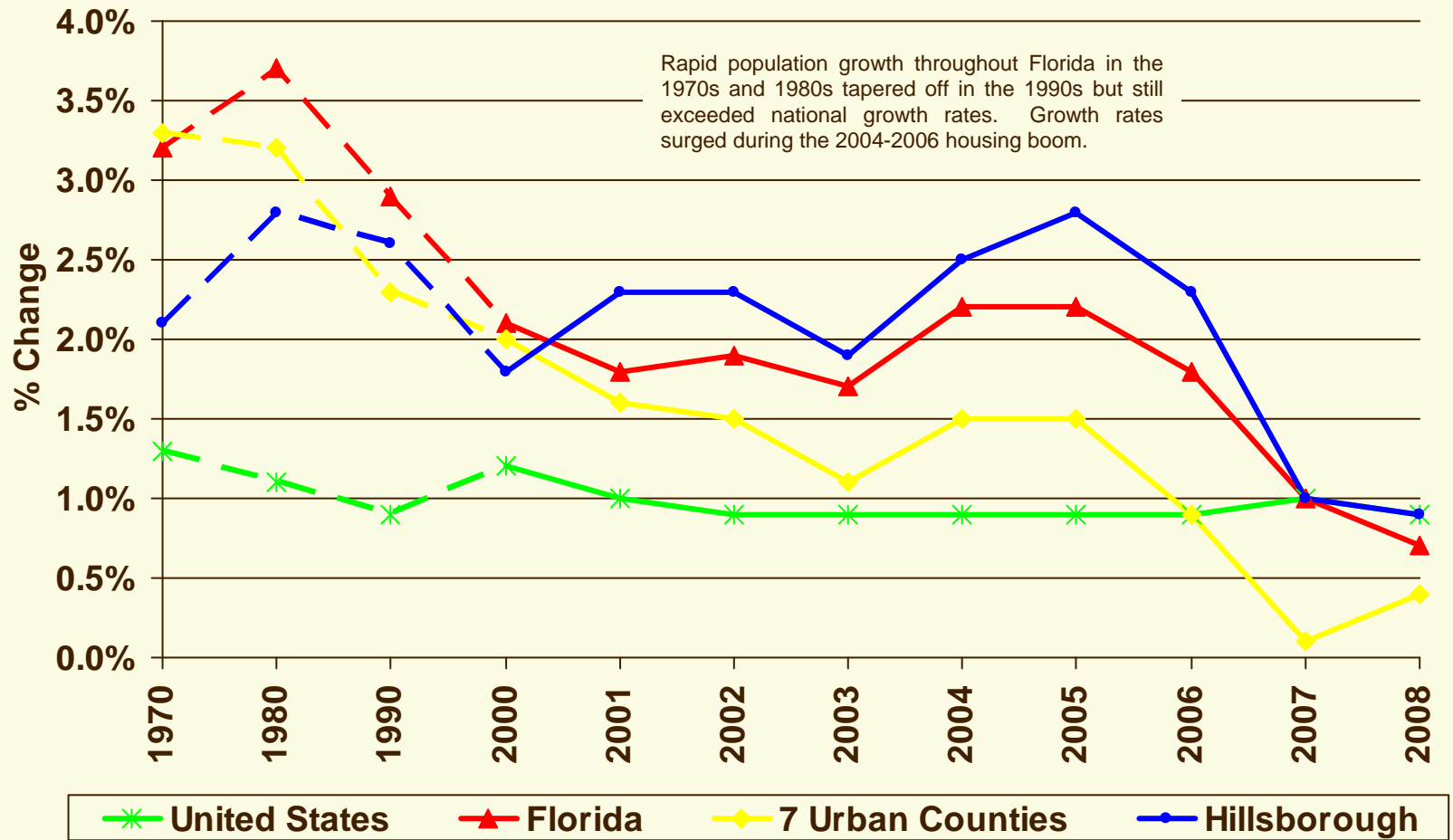
# Population Growth Rates, 1970-2008

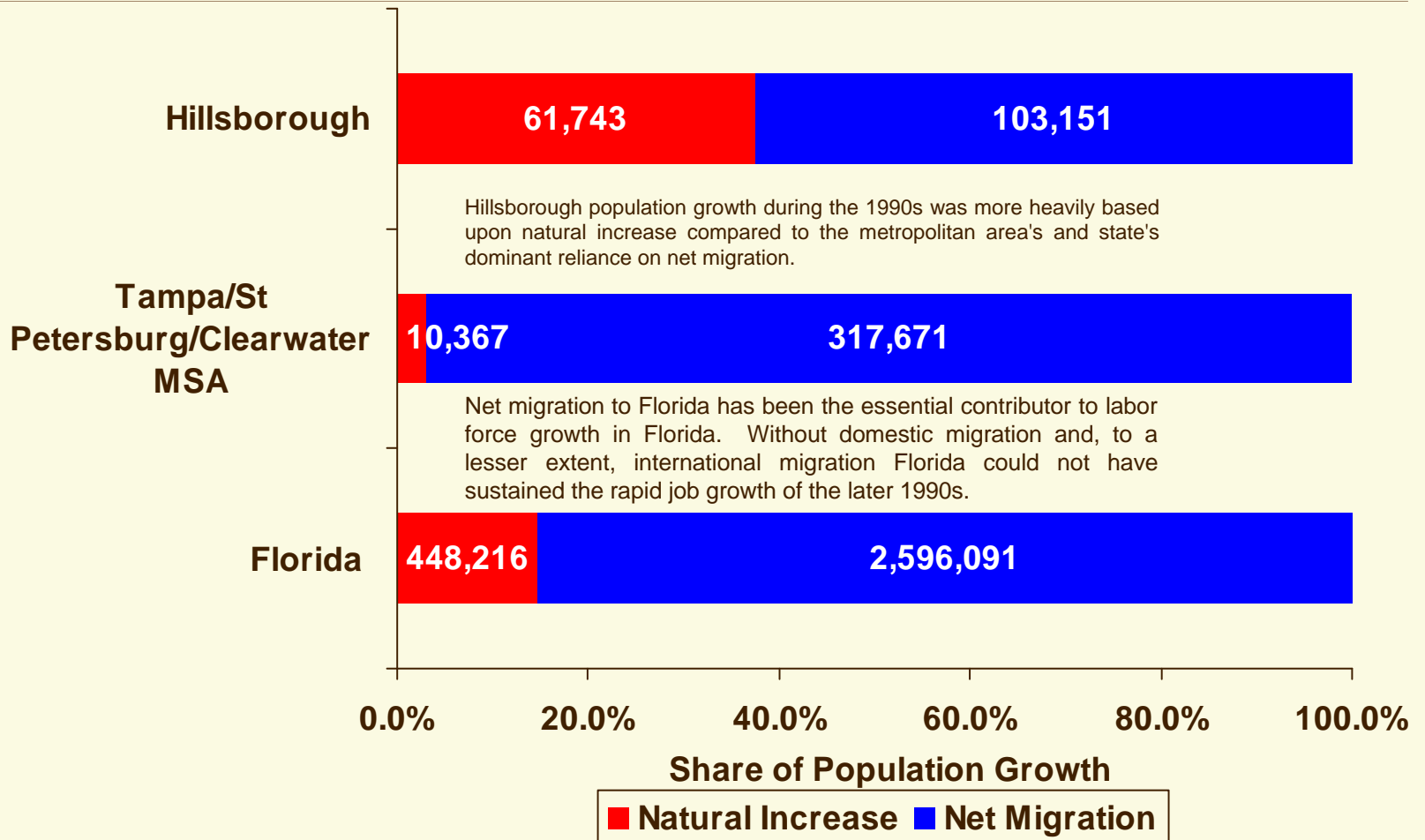
# Annual Population Growth Rates, Large Urban Counties, 1970-2008

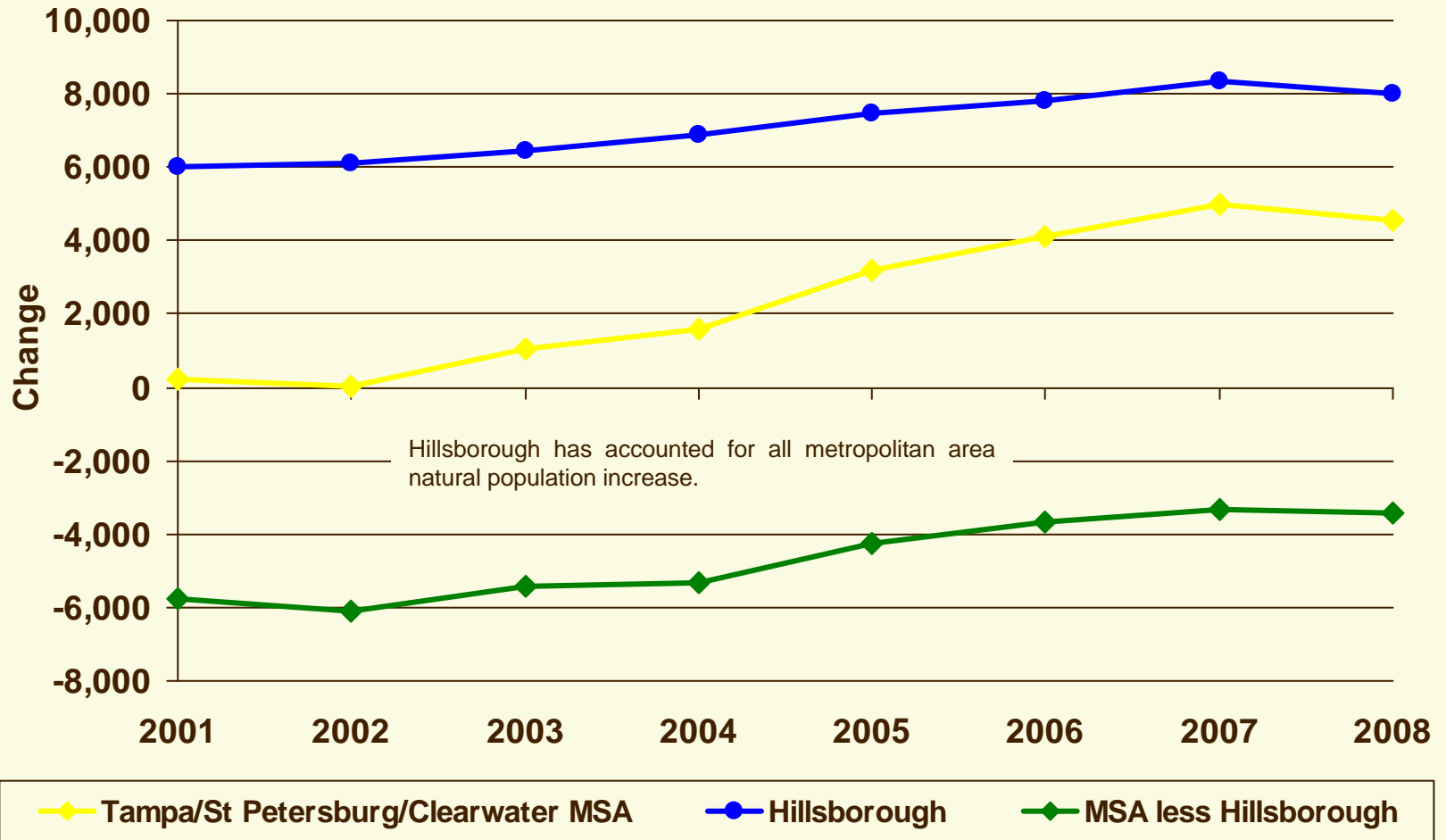
# New Residents by Component of Population Change, 1990-2000



Hillsborough population growth during the 1990s was more heavily based upon natural increase compared to the metropolitan area's and state's dominant reliance on net migration.

Net migration to Florida has been the essential contributor to labor force growth in Florida. Without domestic migration and, to a lesser extent, international migration Florida could not have sustained the rapid job growth of the later 1990s.

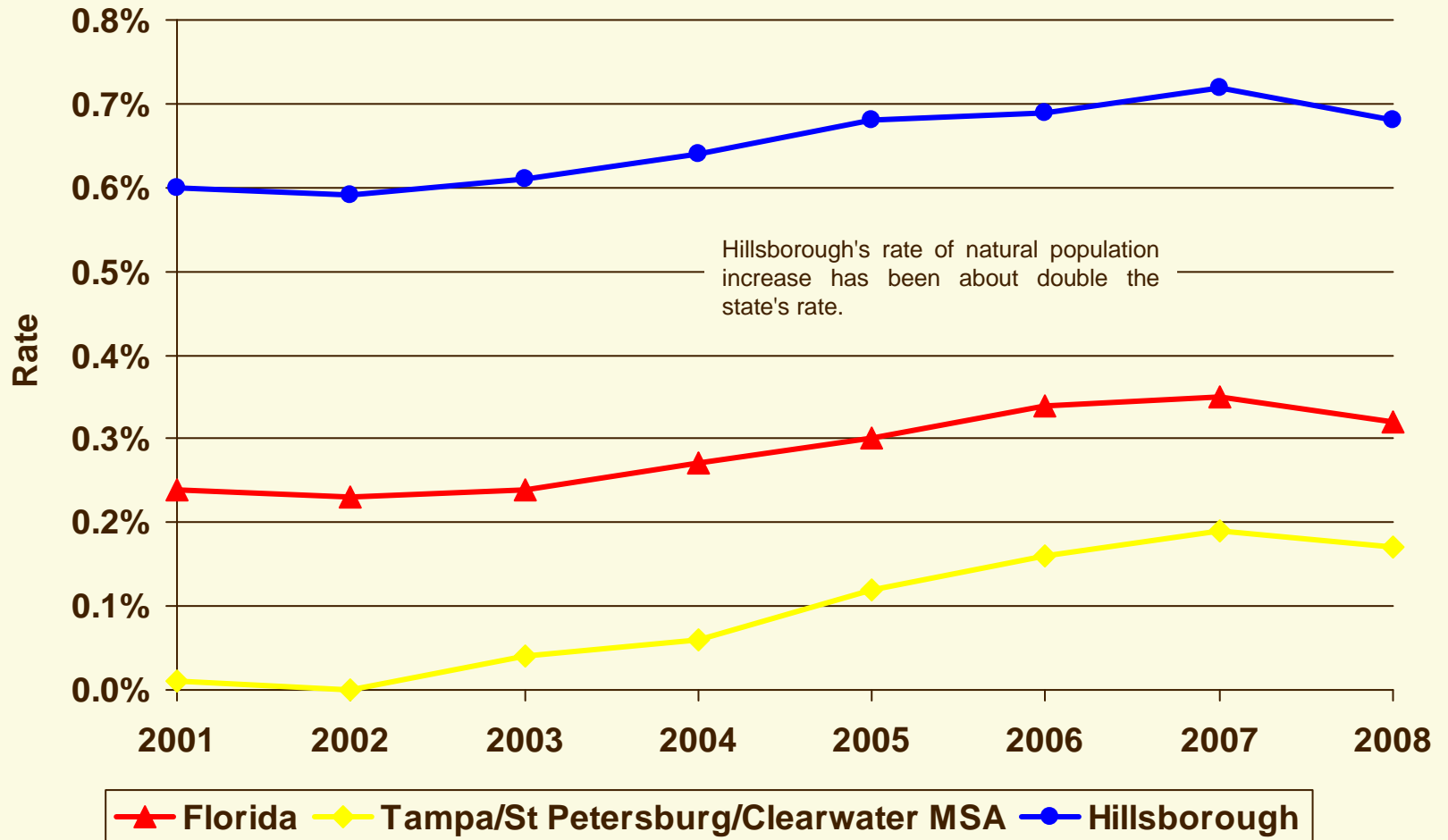
# Natural Population Increase: Births less Deaths

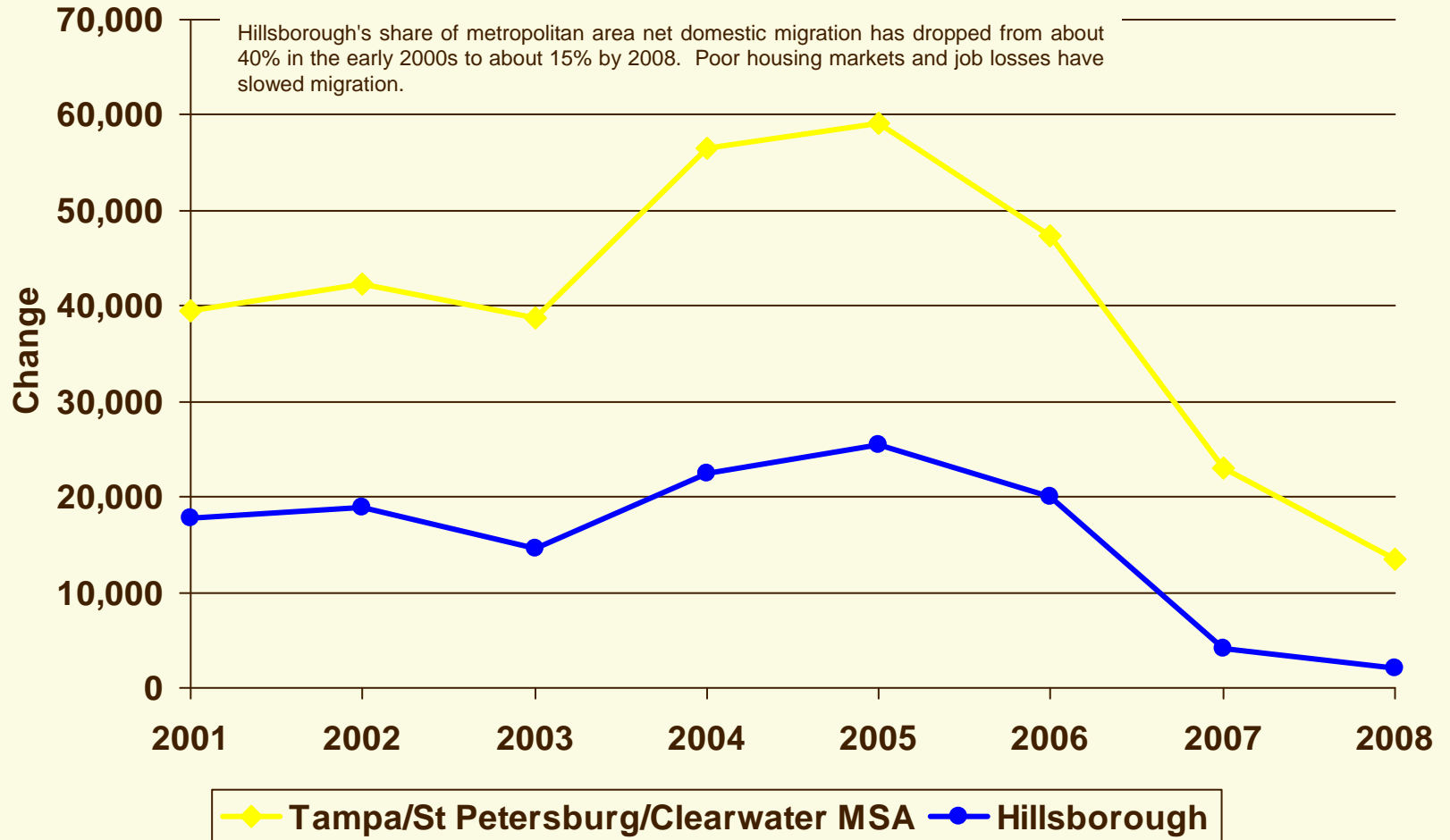
# Rates of Natural Population Increase: Births less Deaths

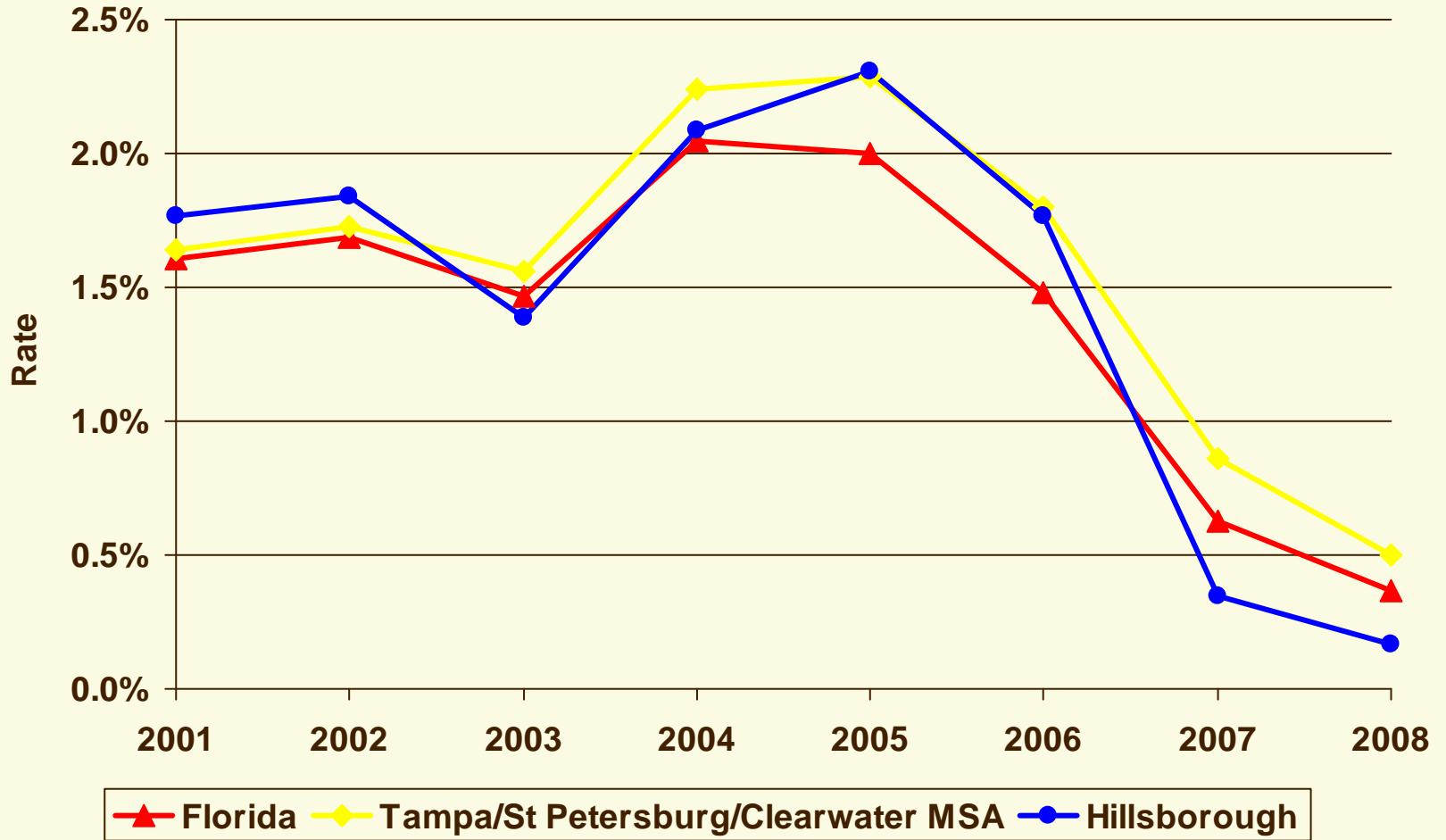
# Net Migration

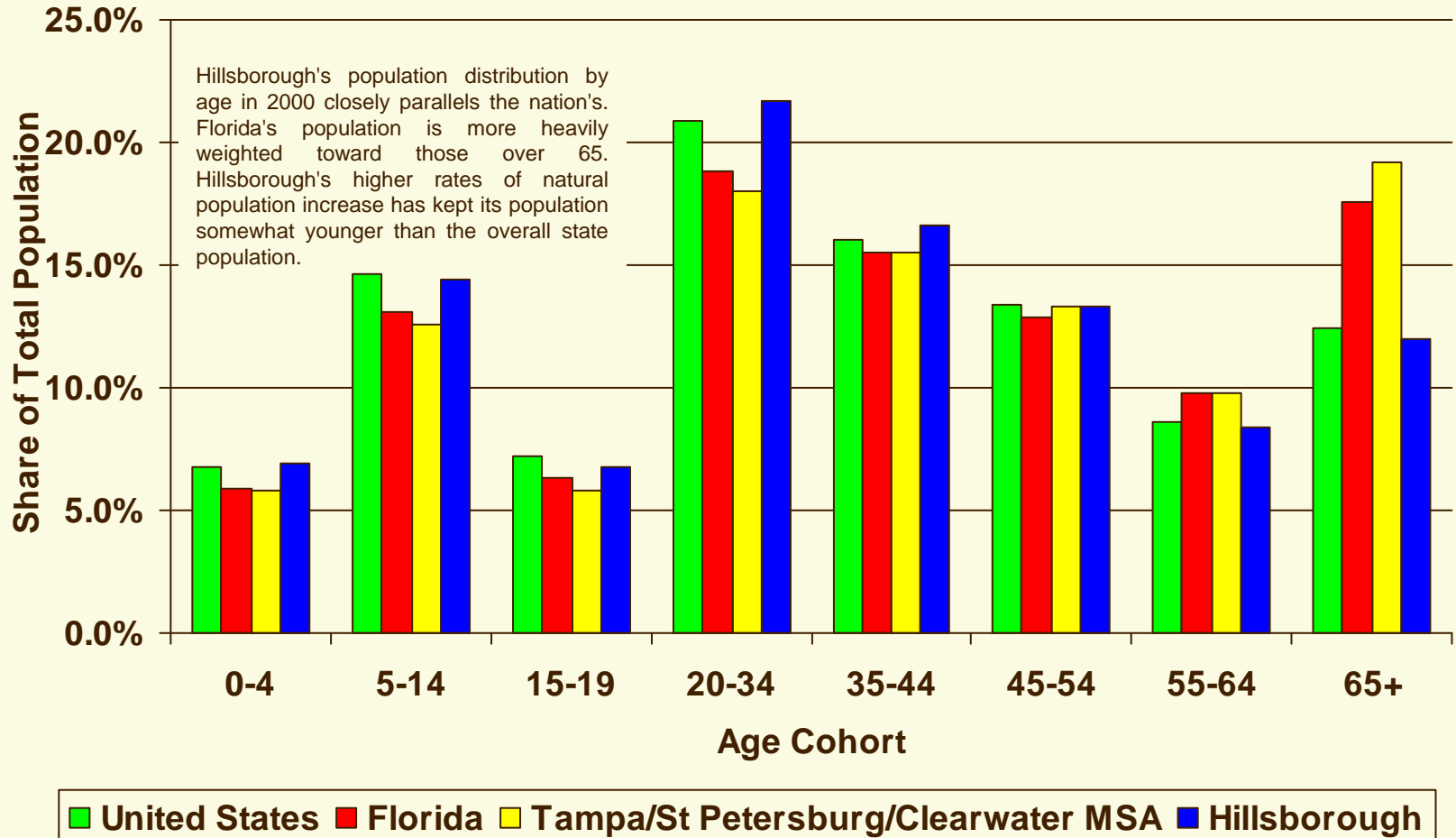
# Rates of Net Migration

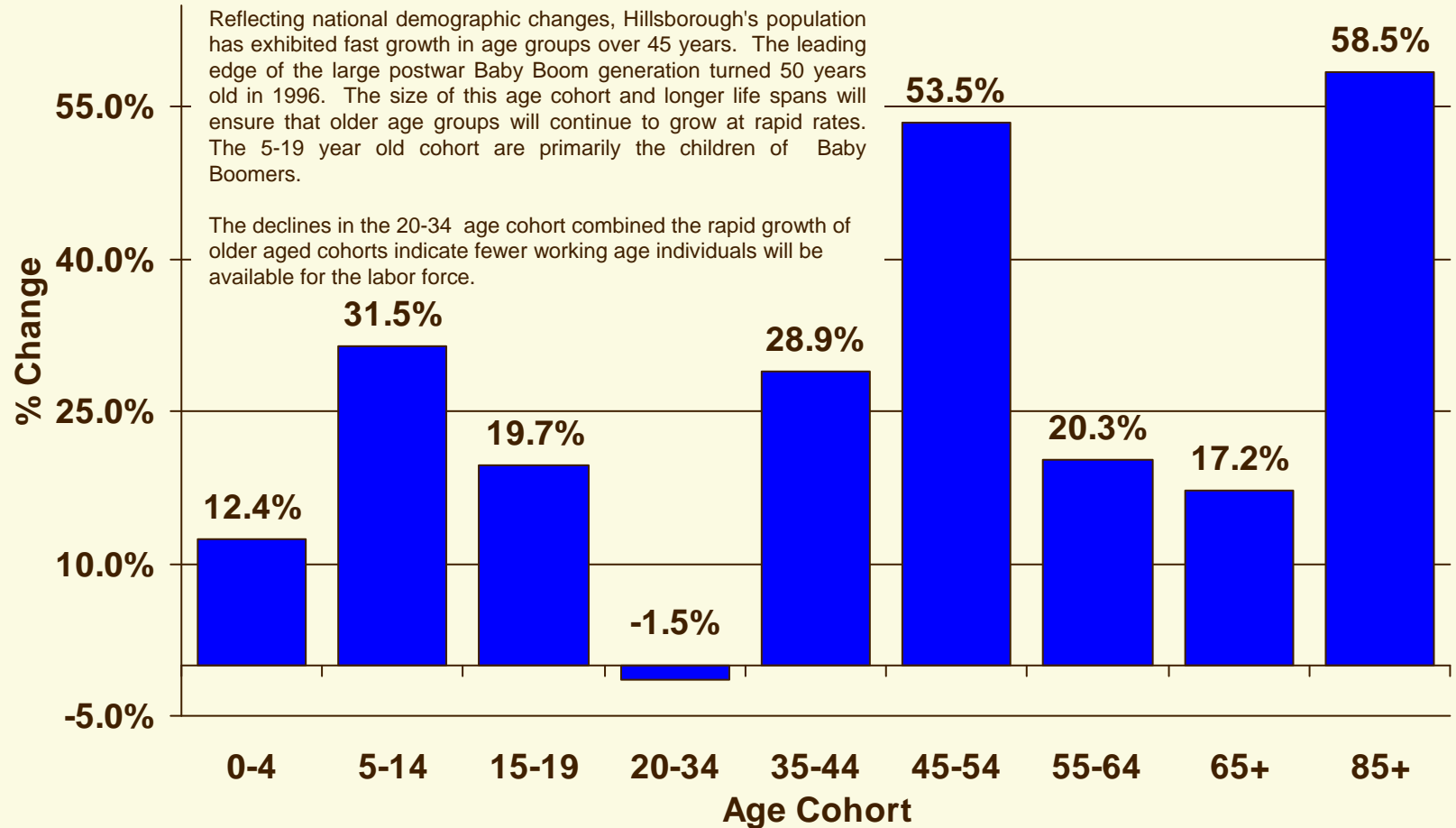
# 2000 Population Distribution by Age

# Hillsborough Population Growth Rates by Age Groups, 1990-2000

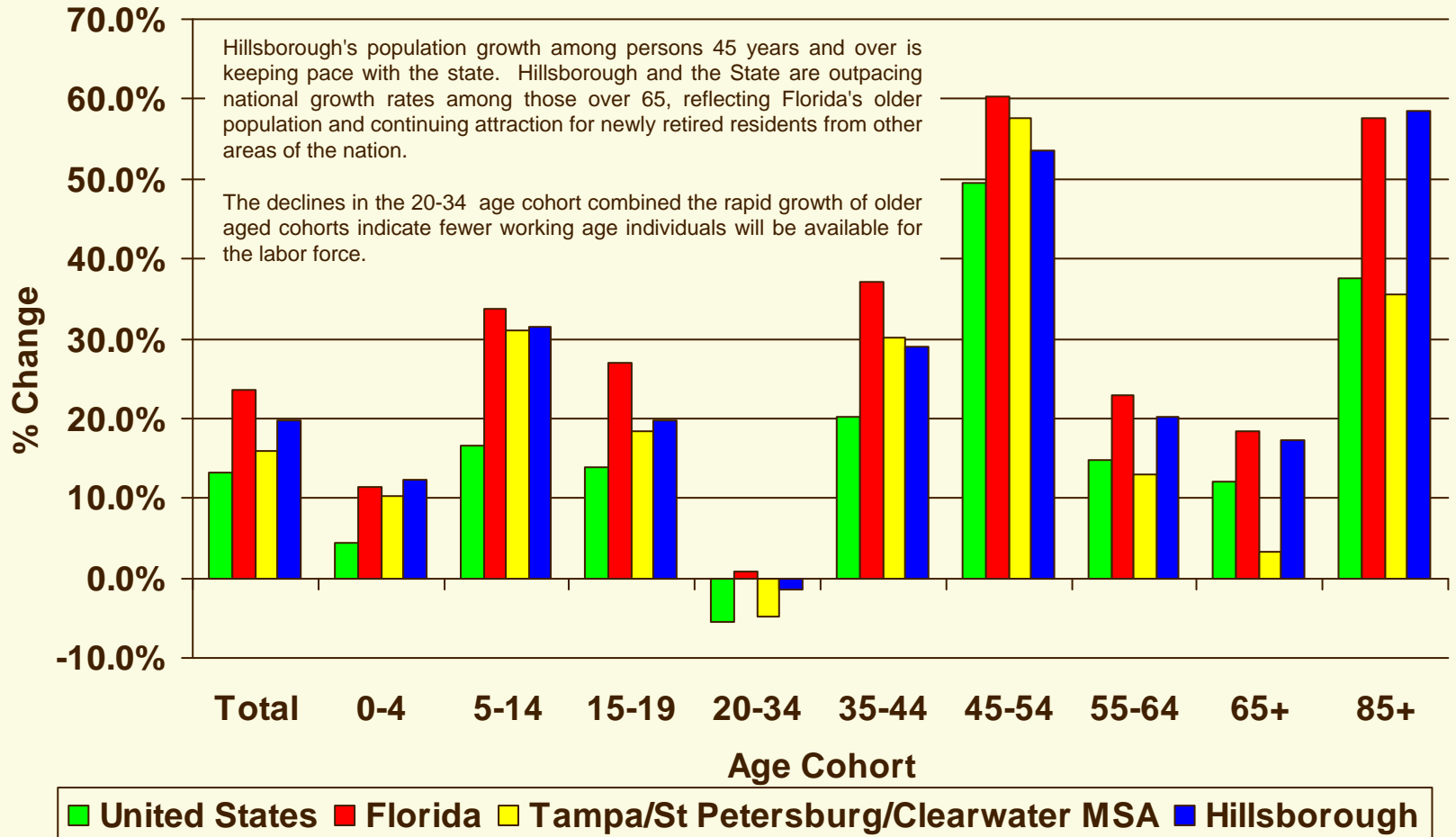

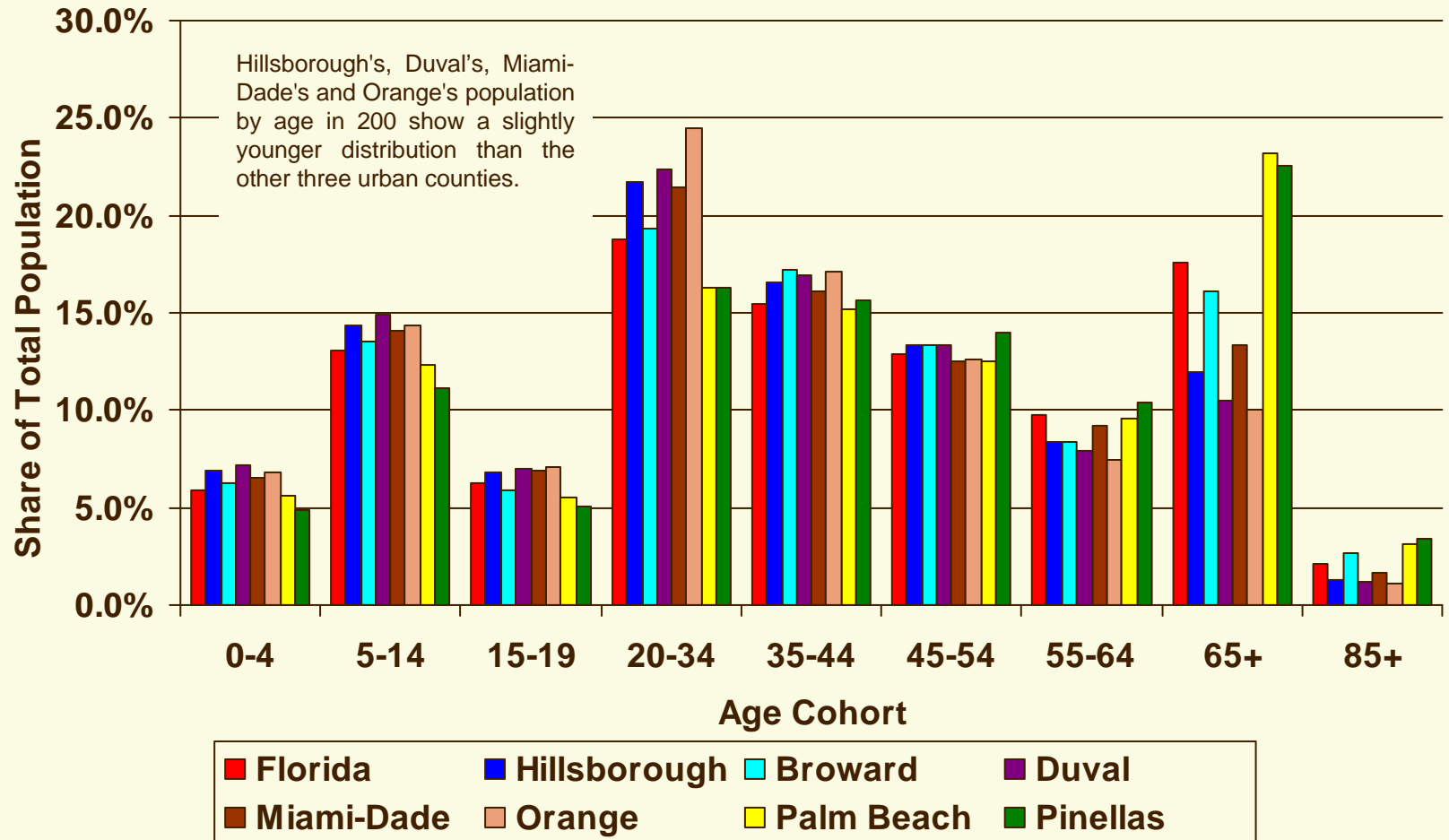

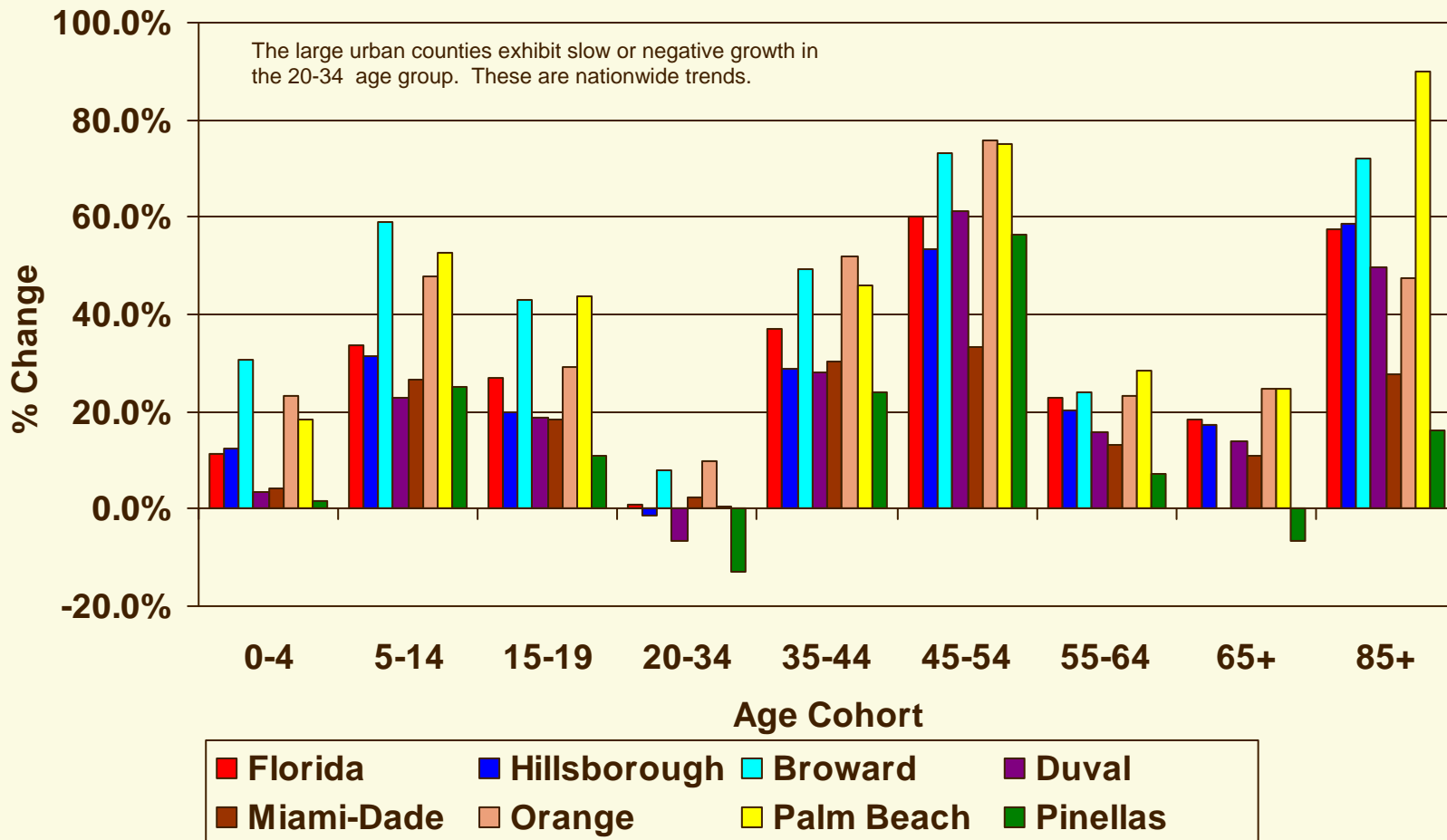
# 2000 Population Distribution by Age, Large Urban Counties
