



E.G Simmons Park Chili Contest Entry Form

Saturday, Feb. 25, from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m.

1. Open to everyone. Minors may enter if accompanied by an adult.
2. The park will provide a 12x12 space at the pavilion.
3. Contestants must make at least 5 gallons of chili to be eligible.
4. All chili must be cooked on location, no precooking allowed. Meats may be cut in advance.
5. Contestants must be ready to begin cooking by 8 a.m., must be ready to serve by 11 a.m., and must provide their own cooking equipment. Set-up begins at 6 a.m.
6. All types of beans and meats can be used.
7. Some people attending the event might have food allergies. Therefore, all ingredients must be listed on a sign, and the sign must be clearly displayed at the cook-off. A copy of the ingredients must also be provided to the judges.
8. Each contestant must have a name for their chili. For example, "flamingo fire."
9. Contestants must decorate their space. The idea is to have lots of fun!
10. There are no judging categories. However, labels to indicate mild, medium, hot or crazy, would be appreciated.
11. A cash prize will be awarded by a panel of judges to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner. The winners of the *People's Choice* and *Best Decorated Booth* will receive trophies.
12. There is a \$2 entry fee per vehicle to enter the park. (County fee that can't be waived)
