

RESOLUTION NO. 112-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PLANT CITY, FLORIDA TO ADOPT AND SUPPORT THE COUNTY-WIDE LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY 2009 UPDATE.

WHEREAS, City of Plant City is located in an area that is vulnerable to natural and manmade disasters; and

WHEREAS, a local mitigation strategy is a plan which presents a unified strategy toward building a disaster-resilient community; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 1999 the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 148-1999, supporting and adopting the first county-wide Local Mitigation Strategy for Hillsborough County; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (the "Act") requires each local jurisdiction to have either its own local mitigation plan or to actively participate in the development and maintenance of multi-jurisdictional mitigation plans; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 Act significantly expanded the mitigation planning requirements in order for state and local jurisdictions to maintain their eligibility for Federal hazard mitigation funds; and

WHEREAS, the LMS 2009 Update was developed by Hillsborough County, the City of Plant City, the City of Tampa, the City of Temple Terrace, community interests, stakeholders, and the communitywide Local Mitigation Strategy Working Group; and

WHEREAS, the LMS 2009 Update has received conditional approvals by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the State Division of Emergency Management (DEM); and

WHEREAS, the State and Federal conditional approvals of the LMS 2009 Update will become final upon adoption of the LMS by the Board of County Commissioners and City of Plant City; City of Tampa, and City of Temple Terrace; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PLANT CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Local Mitigation Strategy 2009 Update developed by the Local Mitigation Strategy Working Group, copy of which is on file with City Clerk, is hereby adopted.


Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.

Adopted by the City Commission on June 28, 2010.


