

RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 014

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE COUNTY-WIDE LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY 2009 UPDATE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Hillsborough County is located in an area that is vulnerable to natural and manmade disasters; and

WHEREAS, a local mitigation strategy is a plan which presents a unified strategy toward building a disaster-resilient community; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (the "ACT") has significantly expanded the mitigation planning requirements imposed on both the State and local jurisdictions in order to maintain eligibility for federal mitigation funds; and

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2004, the City Council of the City of Tampa adopted Resolution No. 2004-1426, which approved a County-Wide Local Mitigation Strategy (the "Local Mitigation Strategy"); and

WHEREAS, 44 CFR Sec. 201.6(d) provides that "(a) local jurisdiction must review and revise its (local mitigation strategy) to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and resubmit it (to Federal Emergency Management Agency) for approval within 5 years in order to continue to be eligible for mitigation grant funding."; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2010, the Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. R10-072, which approved the Local Mitigation Strategy 2009 Update developed by Hillsborough County, the City of Plant City, the City of Tampa, the City of Temple Terrace, community interests, stakeholders, and the communitywide Local Mitigation Strategy Working Group ("Local Mitigation Strategy 2009"); and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy 2009 has been forwarded to the City of Tampa for similar action.

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Local Mitigation Strategy 2009, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved in its entirety.
