

INSPECTION SCHEDULE
(October 1, 2011 to December 29, 2011)

OCTOBER 1 – DECEMBER 29, 2011 – TAXICABS.

Due to the large number of taxicabs, there will be a two month period of inspection. There will be no extensions granted to individuals (owner operators). The Certificate Holder shall direct a request for any extension to the Director of the HCPTC or Chief Inspector.

OCTOBER 1 – OCTOBER 28, 2011 – VANS.

All van limousines must be presented at the HCPTC office unless the fleet is larger than (15) vehicles. A Certificate Holder with more than fifteen (15) vehicles must coordinate with the Director or Chief Inspector to arrange for the location and date of the inspection.

NOVEMBER 1 – DECEMBER 29, 2011 – HANDICABS.

All handicabs must be presented at the HCPTC office for inspection.

OCTOBER 1 – OCTOBER 28, 2011 – LIMOUSINES.

All limousines with the exception of those Certificate Holders with more than fifteen (15) vehicles, will present the vehicles at the HCPTC office for inspection. Those with more than fifteen (15) vehicles must coordinate with the Director or Chief Inspector to arrange for the location and date of the inspection.

DECEMBER 1 – DECEMBER 29, 2011 – BLS AMBULANCES.

BLS ambulance inspections will be coordinated with the HCPTC Chief Inspector for a time and location to be inspected due to the length of time required for a single vehicle inspection and availability of inspectors.

OCTOBER 1 – DECEMBER 29, 2011 – WRECKERS.

All wrecker Certificate Holders will coordinate with the Chief Inspector for scheduling inspections of facilities and vehicles.

NOTE: For All Vehicles Except Wreckers

In Accordance With HCPTC Rules:

(8.1.12, 8.2.2, 8.3.1, 8.4.2, 8.4.3, 8.5.2); vehicles shall be five (5) model years old or newer when initially inspected to be placed in service. If a permitted vehicle is taken out of service for longer than thirty (30) calendar days, the vehicle will lose its status as a previously in-service vehicle.

(8.1.13, 8.2.3, 8.3.2, 8.4.4, 8.4.5, 8.5.3), a vehicle if currently permitted, cannot exceed ten (10) model years at the point of annual inspection.

Any exception to these rules must be previously approved by the HCPTC Board.
