



The Bull Ring

Equipment: Commercial Mower.

Object: Navigate a tight, challenging obstacle course

Scoring: The competitor who navigates through the obstacle course with the fewest faults shall prevail. Best time becomes the discriminator only if two or more ranking competitors complete the task with the same number of faults.

Faults:

Any Contact with an obstacle shall constitute a fault. An object will be positioned on top of each obstacle (traffic cone) to aid the judge in identifying faults. However, the ball does not necessarily have to fall from the cone to constitute a fault - any contact with the cone or other obstacle shall represent a fault.

A fault shall be assigned each time a competitor makes contact with an on-course obstacle or touches a course boundary line.

Failure to utilize the seat belt shall constitute a fault. The competition shall not progress until the competitor engages the safety belt.

Notes:

No fault shall be assigned if a competitor repositions the equipment to avoid striking an obstacle.

Leaving the outer course safety area, a marked area outside of the competition area, will result in disqualification.

Any action deemed by the judge to be inappropriate or an attempt to circumvent the rules or the spirit of the competition may result in additional faults added to the score or disqualification.

Remember: This is a test of skill - not speed. All scores completed within the overarching timeframe (to be announced on the day of the event) shall be considered.

Note: The information contained herein is intended to provide prospective competitors with an introductory overview of the planned event so all can prepare for the competition. However, the event itself, the rules, assignment of faults, the overarching time limit and equipment style is subject to change without further notice.

Final event information will be posted on the Grounds on the day of the event.
