



Lawn Bowling

Equipment : Backhoe Loader

Object: Using the bucket, navigate a bowling ball through a charted course and knock down the bowling pin.

Scoring: The competitor who knocks down the bowling pin with the fewest faults shall prevail. Time will become the discriminator only when two or more competitors complete the event with the same number of goals and faults.

Notes: Each competitor shall have two attempts (balls) to knock down the bowling pin. Only the ball can make contact with the bowling pin.

Rules: A fault will be assigned for the following infractions or errors:

- Bowling ball leaving the charted course.
- Bucket of excavator touching the ground or side boards.
- Ball must remain in contact with ground surface at all times. No carrying the ball in the bucket. *No use of corner of bucket to 'drag' the ball. Ball must be freely turning. No angling of bucket, bucket must remain parallel to ground.*
- Failure to knock down the bowling pin with the ball. Failure to knock down the bowling pin with one of the two balls will result in no score assignment as the task was not completed.
- Any action deemed by the judge to be inappropriate or an attempt to circumvent the rules or the spirit of the competition may result in additional faults added to the score or disqualification.

Note: The information contained herein is intended to provide prospective competitors with an introductory overview of the planned event so all can prepare for the competition. However, the event itself, the rules, assignment of faults, the overarching time limit and equipment style is subject to change without further notice.
