



PROJECT MANIA

Equipment: Identified asset materials located on-site and/or described in written form.

Object: Using the resources provided, consider the described Public Works-related construction project and provide a written estimation of the job requirements on a formatted form.

Scoring: The competitor who provides the nearest estimate to the actual requirements, within the stated timeframe and with the fewest faults, shall prevail. Best time becomes the discriminator only if two or more competitors complete the task with the same number of faults.

Faults:

- A fault shall be assigned for any incorrect or incomplete responses.
- A fault shall be assigned for each instance of illegible handwriting, as determined by the Judge.
- Any unanswered information requests or inputs shall constitute a fault.

Notes:

- Any action deemed by the judge to be inappropriate or an attempt to circumvent the rules or the spirit of the competition may result in additional faults added to the score or disqualification.
- The Judge shall review the competitor's record, interpret and apply standard accounting and job estimation principles and declare the top finishers, in ranking order. The Judge will also issue a ruling on any questions pertaining to the correctness or completeness of a competitor's response. The Judge's ruling shall be final.

Note: The information contained herein is intended to provide prospective competitors with an introductory overview of the planned event so all can prepare for the competition. However, the event itself, the rules, assignment of faults, the overarching time limit and equipment style is subject to change without further notice.

Final event information will be posted on the Grounds on the day of the event.
