



## SURVEYING AMERICA

**Equipment:** Standard Survey Equipment

**Object:** Secure accurate station, offset and elevation information from asset locations and survey rod readings taken on a course and record the information on a response card.

**Scoring:** The competitor who returns the most accurate information shall prevail. Best time becomes the discriminator only if two or more competitors complete the task with the same number of correct responses.

**Faults:**

- An incorrect distance measurement shall result in a fault.
- Incorrect elevation, station or offset measurements shall result in a fault.
- Illegible entries on the report card shall be assigned a fault. Two or more illegible entries shall result in disqualification.

**Notes:**

- Any action deemed by the judge to be inappropriate or an attempt to circumvent the rules or the spirit of the competition may result in additional faults added to the score or disqualification.
- Failure to collect a measurement or reading at all points shall result in a non-qualifying score.
- The Judge's interpretation, evaluation and subsequent rulings pertaining to competitor's responses shall be final.
