



Yard Darts

Equipment: Vehicle with Grappler Arm (Clam Bucket)

Object: Using the grappler, secure and drop one of two darts into a scoring ring located on the ground and return grappler arm to the original starting position.

Scoring: The competitor who completes the task with the fewest faults shall prevail. Best time becomes the discriminator only if two or more ranking competitors complete the task with the same number of faults.

Faults:

A fault shall be assigned for any dart tip that strikes or drops outside of a scoring ring.

A fault shall be assigned if a dart tip is lowered below the top edge of the standing pipe.

Notes:

Competitor must drop one ring into a scoring ring.

Grappler arm must be returned to the starting point after the last dart attempt is made to stop the competition.

Any dart that drops within the ring area but fails to stick in the ground will be considered a score.

A dart that drops and strikes the ring edge but falls outside of the ring area will not be considered a score but a fault. (see above)

Note: The information contained herein is intended to provide prospective competitors with an introductory overview of the planned event so all can prepare for the competition. However, the event itself, the rules, assignment of faults, the overarching time limit and equipment style is subject to change without further notice.
