

WHAT IS RECYCLING?

DEFINITIONS:

- The processing of used materials into new products in order to prevent wasting potentially useful materials and to conserve natural resources
- The processing or re-manufacturing of used or waste material so that it can be used again
- Taking something old and making something new

The universal recycling symbol of the 3 chasing arrows is a *MOBIUS* (unending) loop. It represents a hierarchy of preferred methods of managing waste.



green theme

1 – **REDUCE** waste

2 – **REUSE** waste

3 – **RECYCLE** waste

Each arrow in the mobius loop corresponds to one of these preferences.
