

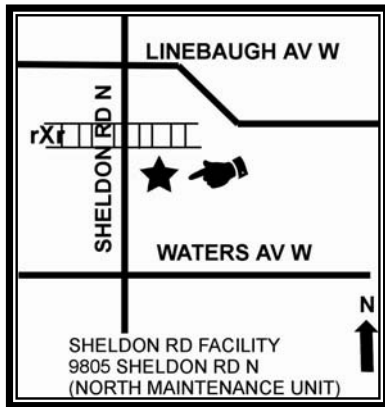

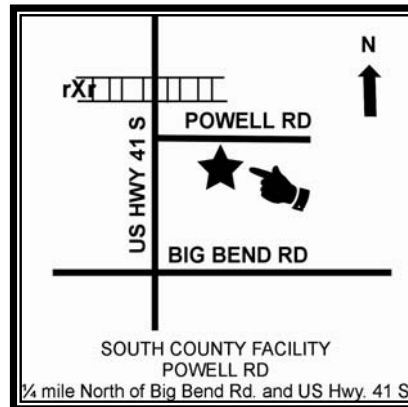

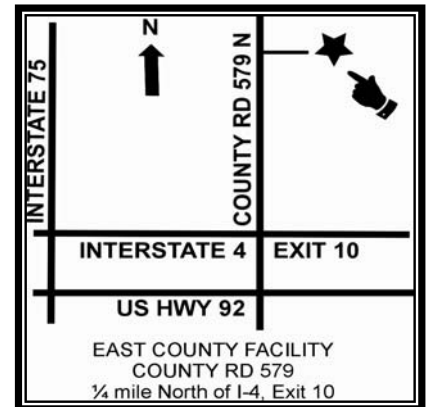

(NOTE: Large/oversized loads may not be accepted, at the discretions of staff, due to capacity.)

NO COMMERCIAL/BUSINESS RELATED ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ACCEPTED HOUSEHOLD PRODUCTS

ELECTRONICS ACCEPTED, but not limited to:

Computers	Monitors	Stereo Components
Computer Components	Microwave Ovens	Telephones/Cell phones
Copiers	Printers	Televisions
Fax Machines	Radios	Toasters
Laptop Computers	Scanners	VCR/DVD Players

PLEASE NOTE: Residents are asked to limit electronics to no more than 5 items. (A computer system: monitor, CPU, printer, keyboard and mouse are considered as one item.)

SAFE TRANSPORT OF HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS

Home owners should take precautions when transporting their chemicals to the **HOME SAFE HOME** collections.

Transport items in the trunk or rear of your vehicle in sturdy boxes/containers that can be thrown away. Boxes may be lined with kitty litter in case of a leak.

Do **NOT** mix materials. Liquids should not be transported to the collection in the same box/container as dry chemicals.



Label all containers when possible

Bring products in their original containers when possible.

Ensure that the containers are not leaking.

Do **NOT** place the items in your vehicle until you are ready to go to the collection.

Please drive with your windows open when bringing the chemicals to a collection. Do **NOT** transport chemicals in the passenger area of your vehicle if possible.

Chemical wastes accepted at Hillsborough County's **HOME SAFE HOME** Chemicals and Electronics collections are disposed of only at sites approved by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Most are rendered harmless through chemical treatment at disposal sites outside of Florida, or are recycled. Hillsborough County saves money on the cost of disposal by recycling as many of these materials as possible.

Used oil, car batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, paints, computer, and computer components are examples of materials that we are recycling. By intercepting and safely disposing of these wastes, Hillsborough County reduces the amount of pollutants entering the environment. In addition to reducing air, water and soil pollution in Hillsborough County, residents participating in the **HOME SAFE HOME** collections can take pride in knowing they are doing their part to help clean up the environment.

If improperly disposed of, **Hazardous Products** can:

Cause a fire or release toxic fumes,
Pose a health risk for collectors,
Contaminate the groundwater supply and the environment.

A substance is hazardous if it is:

TOXIC: directly or indirectly poisons living things,
IGNITABLE: capable of catching fire,
CORROSIVE: capable of chemically eroding another substance such as cloth, metal or skin,
REACTIVE: capable of participating in a chemical interaction or transformation,
CARCINOGENIC: capable of causing cancer.

Please **DO NOT** set Household Chemicals and Electronics out for curbside collection. Please **DO NOT** take Household Chemicals to the Community Collection Centers, nor pour chemicals down the drain or on the ground. Please **DO** take them to one of the Hillsborough County **HOME SAFE HOME** Household Chemicals and Electronics Collection sites for safe disposal. Household Electronics **ARE** accepted at the Community Collection Centers 6 days a week.

ITEMS **NOT** ACCEPTED AT THE **HOME SAFE HOME** HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS AND ELECTRONICS COLLECTIONS:

Some battery powered **ionization-type smoke detectors** may contain radioactive materials. Return old smoke detectors to the manufacturer. Use **non-ionizing photoelectric** type smoke detectors instead.

Home Health Care products such as needles/sharps and other possible Bio-Hazardous waste should be taken to a major medical facility for proper disposal.

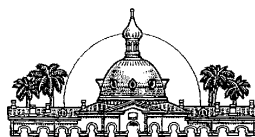
Radioactive Materials: Contact the Florida Department of Health, Bureau of Radiation Control.

Bio-Medical Wastes: Consult bio-medical waste companies, a local hospital, or the local Health Department.

Explosives: Contact local law enforcement agencies.

ONLY RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLD MATERIALS WILL BE ACCEPTED!
(NOTE: Large/oversized loads may not be accepted, at the discretions of staff, due to capacity.)

NO Commercial/Business related materials will be accepted at the HOME SAFE HOME Household Chemicals and Electronics Collections. Contact a Hazardous Waste Collector or contact the Hillsborough County Public Utilities Department, Solid Waste Management Division at (813) 272-5680.
