WHO CAN BE A MEMBER OF THE VETERANS COUNCIL?

The council will be comprised of recognized National Veteran's Organizations whose members served in the armed forces of the United States and/or their Auxiliaries. In addition, Veterans organizations that abide by the constitution of the United States and are not national in scope along with associate members may be granted membership.

WHAT IS THE COST TO VETERAN'S ORGANIZATIONS TO JOIN PER YEAR?

Each Member from all Veteran's Organizations shall pay annual dues. The term runs from October 1 to September 30 of each year. The dues are \$20.00 per year. Each Organization has only one voting member – all others are considered Associate Members. Honorary members pay no dues.

WHY SHOULD A VETERANS'S ORGANIZATION BELONG TO THE COUNCIL?

Each organization should have a representative actively involved in the Council's meetings and activities in an attempt to provide unity, leadership, community involvement, and assist with the coordination of serving as a liaison between county government, Veterans' Affairs of Hillsborough County and Veterans' Organizations. Additionally, each organization should work together to promote patriotic programs throughout the year with special emphasis on Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Patriots' Day (9/11/01), POW/MIA Day and Veterans' Day. The Council should be representative of all veterans' organizations within Hillsborough County.
