

## **Recap of the Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting March 25, 2016**

The March 25, 2016, Hillsborough County Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting was called to order by Chair Lowry at 8:30 a.m. CAC members in attendance were: Chair Lee Lowry, Vice Chair Kay Doughty, Cristan Fadal, Spencer Kass, Joe Caetano, Linda Porter, Joe Wicker, Barbara Aderhold and Adam Bantner. CAC members absent were: Ron Govin and Wendell Duggins. A quorum was present. County staff in attendance: Beth Cardenas.

The Pledge of Allegiance and an explanation of the role and responsibilities of the CAC were given.

**Meeting Recap:** The February 26, 2016 meeting recap was reviewed and approved.

**Presentation on Code Enforcement:** Ron Spiller, Director of Code Enforcement, gave a presentation on the department. This presentation included their mission, organizational structure, operations, administration, resource management, and new approaches. He also discussed enforcement on foreclosed homes. He discussed a FEMA meeting on April 5 and other upcoming public meetings. He discussed risk/threats and vulnerabilities. He also discussed changing maps and construction requirements. He also discussed stormwater. The CAC requested an update on the previously discussed projects regarding stormwater and the Summer 2015 flooding.

3. LED streetlights and any cost savings

Mr. Fadal requested an update on the subcommittee topics: customer service, Parks & Recreation, and ELAPP. Mr. Wicker and Mr. Kass discussed an interest in an update on Go Hillsborough. The CAC spoke to past and future involvement in the budget process. They also discussed infrastructure maintenance costs. The CAC passed a motion to write a letter to the BOCC requesting advocacy for diversified spending of affordable housing dollars.
