



Recap of the Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting

June 28, 2019

The June 28, 2019, Hillsborough County Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting was called to order by Chair Eric Johnson at 8:30 a.m.

Members Present: Chair Eric Johnson, Vice Chair Jen McDonald, Barbara Aderhold, Kay Doughty, Noelle Licor, Tu Mai, Joseph Odda, and Linda Porter.

Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Introductions: The Pledge of Allegiance was held.

Review of Meeting Recap: A motion was made by Mr. Odda to approve the May 24, 2019 CAC meeting recap. Mrs. Aderhold seconded the motion. *The motion carried unanimously.*

Summary of County-wide survey: Liana Lopez, Chief Communications Administrator for Hillsborough County presented a summary of the results of the preliminary County-wide citizen survey report. The report showcased the satisfactions and concerns of Hillsborough County citizens and identified expectation gaps where the County population expects more from government. Mrs. Lopez stated she expected the final report on July 12, 2019. Committee Chair Johnson requested that Mrs. Lopez have the consultant visit to present the final report at the July 19, 2019, meeting. Intergovernmental Relations Jim Taylor will assist in setting a time for the consultant to visit at the next meeting.

Review of Sunshine Law: Hillsborough Deputy County Attorney Mary-Helen Farris attended the meeting to review Sunshine Law and how it applies to the Committee's business. Farris noted that the State of Florida leads the nation in its open government laws.
