



Recap of the Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting

July 19, 2019

The July 19, 2019, Hillsborough County Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting was called to order by Chair Eric Johnson at 8:30 a.m.

Members Present: Chair Eric Johnson, Vice Chair Jen McDonald, Barbara Aderhold, Marlin Anderson, Kay Doughty, Tu Mai, Linda Porter, Joseph Pullara, and Joe Walters.

Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Introductions: The Pledge of Allegiance was held.

Public Comment: None.

New Member Introduction: Joe Walters was introduced by Chair Johnson. Mr. Walters gave a brief introduction to members.

Review of Meeting Recap: A motion was made by Joe Pullara to approve the June 28, 2019, CAC meeting recap. Kay Doughty seconded the motion. *The motion carried unanimously.*

Continuation of County-wide survey: Chief Communications Administrator Liana Lopez returned to continue the June 28, 2019, discussion of the County-wide survey. The full report was released on July 12, 2019. Mrs. Lopez and HCP Associate consultant, Robert Allen, continued discussion and answered member questions.

County Budget Update: Assistant County Administrator of Financial Services, Tom Fesler, and Management and Budget Director Kevin Brickey attended the meeting to review the FY 20' - FY 21' County Administrator's Recommended Budget. Mr. Fesler's PowerPoint presentation recapped the recommended budget that was presented to the BOCC on July 17th. Jim Taylor will provide an update at the next scheduled CAC meeting on the status of the recommended.

Hurricane Presentation: Emergency Management Planning Chief Marcus Martin attended the meeting to discuss Hurricane Preparedness and encouraged members to share the presented information in their communities. Mr. Martin impressed the importance of following a notice to evacuate, as well as emphasized the change in recommendation for families to now have seven days' worth of resources up from three days.

Chair Johnson reminded the group to finish commissioner meetings before the August meeting. Instructed Mr. Taylor to reach out to County Administration to discuss potential projects for the group to discuss.

A motion was made by Joe Pullara to adjourn the meeting. Marlin Anderson seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 10:18 a.m.
