Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance (Virtual Flag displayed) and Introductions highlighting new members.

Meeting Recap: A motion made by Mr. Elend and seconded by Mr. Pullara to approve the February 26, 2021 CAC meeting recap. The motion carried unanimously.

The committee received 2 presentations, both pertained to the annual workplan subject Municipal Overlay. Commissioner Mariella Smith provided an overview of the Municipal Overlay/ Incorporating strides she made as a resident of Ruskin. Additionally, former Senator President Tom Lee provided his first-hand experience with the Brandon community in the 1980's. He also provided historical context to communities that have looked at the potential benefits of Municipal Overlay/ Incorporating, as well as potential benefits and drawbacks to the concept.
