- Location: Bloomingdale
- Length: 3.1 miles, from Boyette Road to Bloomingdale Avenue
- Category: Construction
- Schedule: Late 2018-2022

### Overview

- Widen Bell Shoals Road from a two-lane roadway to a divided four-lane roadway with raised, landscaped medians
- Provide two vehicle lanes, a bicycle lane, and a sidewalk in each direction
- Widen the existing bridge over the Alafia River
- Upgrade the existing traffic signals at Glenhaven Drive, Rosemead Lane, and Bloomingdale Avenue
- Add a new traffic signal at Starwood Avenue
- Enhance pedestrian safety features, including upgrades to comply with current ADA regulations
- Improve stormwater drainage

### Benefits

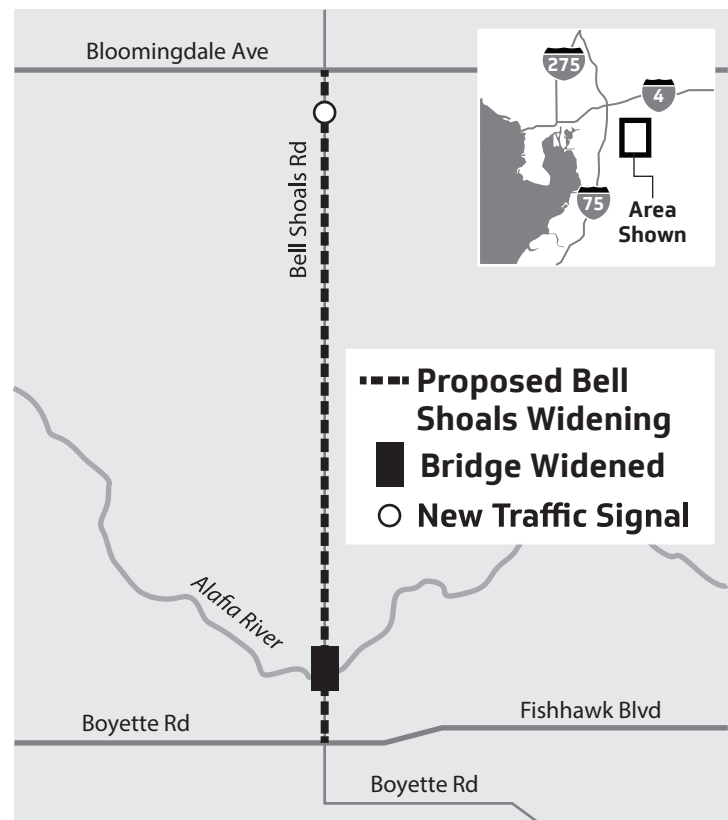
- Better accommodate growth and traffic volume
- Increase the overall mobility along Bell Shoals Road, while maximizing safety along the corridor

### Cost Estimate

- Total: \$65 million
  - Design: \$5 million
  - Land Acquisition: \$20 million
  - Construction: \$40 million

### Project Funding

- Local Gas Tax: \$8 million
- Community Investment Tax (CIT): \$27 million
- General and Other Revenue Funds: \$10 million
- Public Utilities Relocation Fund: \$4 million
- Developer Contribution: \$16 million
